1. Venue

1.1 The Venue will be YCJ – Yacht Club Jermak

1.2 Races will be sailed on Lubie Lake.

Lubie Lake is situated in North Western part of Poland within Pomeranian Lakes District some 100km SE of Szczecin (Stettin) and only 200km from Berlin

The lake is fresh water and non tidal.

3. Eligibility

All competitors (skippers and crew) shall comply with the ISAF Eligibility Code (ISAF Regulation 19, RRS Appendix 2).

The regatta is open to boats of the Vaurien class complying with the class rules.

The entry fee will be Euro – 150,00 – for each boat. Entry fees are not refundable.

The organizing authority must have received Pre Entry Forms not later than – 31 May 2017.

4. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

- No national prescriptions shall apply
- Vaurien World Championship Rules will apply
- Changes of Sailing Instructions will be posted at the official notice board.
- Coach boats are permitted on the Lubie Lake
- Protesting boats need to display conspicuously a red flag at the first reasonable opportunity. This changes rule 61.1 (a) (2)

5. Measurement

All boats will be checked for compliance with the Class Rules. Measurement will take place at the venue as scheduled in the program.

Any boat and her equipment may be subject to re-measurement or examination at any time during the event.

6. Scoring system

The Low Point Score System of Appendix A of the Racing Rules will apply.

A maximum of twelve races will constitute a series and the championship.

Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score if 6 to 11 races are completed and her two worst scores if 12 races are completed.

7. International jury

An International Jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS Appendix N.

The decision of the Jury shall be final in accordance with RRS 70.4

8. Advertising

The organizing authority may require competing boats to carry event – sponsoring advertising.

Nothing applied to hulls by the organizing authority may be changed or removed during the regatta without written approval of the organizing authority.

9. Accommodation

Camping site, parking for campers will be available at the premises of the – Yacht Club Jermak

Parking for cars, trailers and launching area will be indicated individually during registration.

All competitors will race at their own risk and responsibility both civil and criminal. It shall be the sole responsibility of the helmsman to decide wheatear or not to race or to continue the race. The Organizers the Race Committee an the Jury decline any responsibility whatsoever for damages that might occur to persons and/or objects during the races or in situations of rescue, both ashore and on the water, as a consequence of their participation in the races.

Liability Insurances are required for all competing yachts (Rule 68 R.R). The policy must be shown at the completion of registration. The minimum of insurance is 1.500.000 Euro for each boat.

12. Rights to use name and likeness

By participating in the Vaurien World Championships, every sailor automatically grants to the organizing authority and the sponsors of the event the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time and at their discretion, any photos, motion pictures and live, tape or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition without compensation.
